Earn credits towards Martin Tuchman School of Management (MTSM) Master of Science in Management (MSM) or Master of Business Administration in Management of Technology (MBA) as an undergraduate student!

Juniors with 57 credits or more, and a GPA of at least 3.0, may apply to take graduate-level courses to count towards both your business minor and the MTSM MSM or MBA.

Follow these Easy Steps:

Meet with your major advisor and an MTSM academic advisor to:

1. Complete the form for undergraduates to take graduate courses (Form #1)
2. Complete the form for BS/MSM or BS/MBA program (Form #2) – this must be completed to show which courses can be double counted and charged at undergraduate tuition rates when you receive a B or better
3. Consult with your major advisor to find out if minor courses can fulfill requirements within your primary curriculum

Additional advantages for NJIT students when applying for the MTSM MSM or MBA
We will waive your application fee (contact us for the code)
We will waive the GMAT if your NJIT undergraduate GPA is 2.8 or above

How it Works:

Take graduate-level courses and get credit for both your business minor and the Martin Tuchman School of Management MSM or MBA

BS/MSM	30	3.0 and above	6
