BS/MS & BS/MBA Program Info

Application and course registration process:

1. Verify that you have at least Junior standing.
2. Verify that your current cumulative GPA is a minimum of 3.0
3. Apply online through the Office of Admissions here: **Dual Degree Program Application**
4. Admissions will follow-up within 5-7 business via email with any other requirements and whether you have been admitted to the BS/MS program
5. Meet with your Undergraduate Advisor to review your curriculum to determine where you can apply the graduate course(s). You will then contact the Graduate Advisor to select a graduate course that you would like to take.
 - i. You can also consult with your major advisor to find out if minor courses can fulfill requirements within your primary curriculum.
6. Once you have selected the course(s) that you plan to take, you will need to fill out the BS/MS registration form: **Undergraduate Students Taking Graduate Courses as Part of the Joint Degree Program.**
7. The completed form (with the advisors' signatures) will need to be submitted to the Office of the Registrar. The Office of Registrar will enroll you in the graduate course(s).

Additional Advantages for NJIT Students When Applying for the MSM or MBA

- We will waive your application fee (contact us for the code)
- We will waive the GMAT if your NJIT undergraduate GPA is 2.8 or above

How Does it Work?

Program	Total Credits for the MSM and MBA	Undergraduate GPA Requirement	Maximum grad-level credits that can be double counted (must receive a B or better grade)
BS/MSM	30	3.0 and above	6
BS/MSM	30	3.5 and above	9

BS/MBA	36	3.0 and above	12

If you are interested in getting a business minor and in either the MSM or MBA program, you can substitute graduate courses for the undergraduate courses.
